We are happy to invite children and teenagers to take part in the competition. We accept applications from individuals, educational institutions, cultural institutions and schools. The winners of the competition, together with their supervisors, will be invited to participate in a several-day seaside art workshop, as part of the grand finale of the Color Art Festival. They will also receive catalogs and diplomas.

The festival is an annual event held since 1990. It is a continuation of the International Festival of Children's Art, under the patronage of the Polish UNESCO Committee. Its goal is the widest possible promotion of all forms of artistic creativity practiced by young artists, and creating opportunities for artistic expression on a given topic.

AWARDS AND DISTINCTIONS

AWARDS

The prize in the competition is an invitation to participate in a several-day seaside art workshop for the Laureate and one guardian, and the presentation of the work at the post-competition exhibition and festival catalog.

In the PAINTING category - the winners of the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in each age category will be invited to the workshops.

In the GRAPHICS category - the winners of the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in each age category will be invited to the workshops.

In the POWIAT category - the winners of the first place in each age category will receive an invitation to the workshop.

The jury reserves the right to divide the prizes differently.

Each Winner of the competition will be awarded only one prize.

The artistic supervisors of the Laureates will receive letters of appreciation.

DISTINCTIONS

The committee may award up to three distinctions in each of the categories. The form of distinction is the presentation of the work at the exhibition and in the festival catalog as well as the diploma.

SUBMITTING ENTRIES

Only artworks on paper or canvas will be accepted

Acceptable sizes: Painting – A3 - A1,

Graphic Arts – A4 - A2.

In the Graphic Arts category we will accept works made using linocut and monotyping techniques.

Original works should be sent to the address of the Goleniów Cultural Center **by January 31, 2023** (as evidenced by the date as postmarked). On the back of the work, the application form should be placed along with the declaration of consent to the processing of personal data of the participant signed by the legal guardian (Annex to the regulations).

Each contestant can submit up to 3 pieces.

Artwork must be created by the contestant alone.

The artwork will not be returned.

The works should be sent in appropriate packaging to prevent damage (not rolled up).

Works should be sent unframed and non-lined.

Pieces of art sent from outside the European Union should be sent as a postal parcel containing documents. Letters containing only documents or correspondence remain free of customs and tax charges.

ANNOUNCEMENT OF RESULTS

Information about the results of the competition will be published on the website www.gdk.goleniow.pl by March 14, 2023.

The winners will receive an invitation to the finale of the Festival and workshops by phone and e-mail by March 31, 2023.

The grand finale of the Color Art Festival

The opening of the exhibition and artistic workshops will take place on May 8 - 12, 2023 in Goleniów and Międzywodzie.

During the Festival, the Organizers provide the Laureate and one Guardian with accommodation and meals. The costs of arrival from / to the place of residence are covered by the Participant.

Confirmation of participation is the accreditation fee for the entire stay in the amount of PLN 100 per couple - the Laureate and the Guardian.

All the art materials needed during the workshop activities are provided by the Organizer.

COPYRIGHT AND OWNERSHIP RIGHTS

By entering the competition you acknowledge that Goleniowski Dom Kultury is granted the right to transform and use the works submitted to the festival in their entirety. Works submitted to the festival become the property of the organizer and will not be returned to their authors. Entering the competition is tantamount to transferring, free of charge, the ownership of the submitted artwork to the Organizer. By entering the competition you give your consent to process your personal data, as well as to reproduce your physical likeness in the exhibition catalogue and promotional materials. The organizer reserves the right to change the regulations.

Your personal data will be processed until the end of the competition, and the personal data of the winners, until the consent is revoked.

You have the right to: access the data and rectify it; delete data, when processing is not carried out in order to fulfill an obligation, resulting from a legal provision, or in the exercise of public authority; restrict data processing or object to their processing; withdraw the consent in the event that the processing of data takes place on the basis of the consent granted; lodge a complaint to the President of the Personal Data Protection Office when the processing of personal data violates the law.

Providing personal data is voluntary, but necessary to participate in the festival.
